ABOUT THE ROLE

This role works as part of professionals providing high-calibre technical services to a range of clients across multiple fine art genres in an exciting new venue environment. As a Casual Duty Technician, you will act in the role of supporting the technical team across a range of different disciplines including that of; lighting, audio-visual and staging services. This role works in having key experience across a range of theatrical and performing art production skills. You'll be required to work across technical teams at Sutherland Arts Theatre, and Pavilion where required. This role will include acting in position of Duty Technician across Pavilion precinct, where leading and managing small technical teams will be required on occasions. The role also facilitates operational and programming of events and productions in both sound, lighting, and staging, and assist the Senior Technicians in delivering high level technical services to the client.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Facilitate audio, lighting and staging requirements for productions that come through the venues.
- Supervise and lead small technical teams for bump in/bump out periods.
- Operate and program sound/av and lighting consoles for events; ETC GIO @5, GrandMA3 Compact, Sound Craft Vi2000
- Ensuring the delivery of a consistently high level of efficient and friendly customer service to both hirers and other key stakeholders
- Ensure infrastructure and venue assets are well maintained, repaired and replaced to achieve a safe working environment.
- Interpret technical drawings and requirements for upcoming productions and achieve deliverables towards the client or stakeholders occupying the venues.
- Assist Pavilion operations where possible and have the ability to work across weekends where required.
